



## Additional CE Requirements

While taking our EMS Refresher satisfies the KBEMS and National Registry continuing education hourly requirement, KBEMS has additional content-specific CE requirements that are required for your renewal. **ALL EMTs and Paramedics** must complete these. They are:

- Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma (PAHT)
- Sexual Violence Awareness (SVA)

You need **one hour** of PAHT and **one hour** of SVA every **two years**. Using KBEMS new continuing education system, CEBroker, it's now easier than ever to complete both of these required CEs, and you can do so at your convenience.

### Accessing CEBroker

- Visit <https://cebroker.com/ky/account/basic/>
- Enter your KY EMT or Paramedic license number, and create your account.
- Keep the free, or "basic" plan. You do not need to upgrade.
- Once created, go to <https://cebroker.com/>
- Click "Sign In" in the upper right hand corner.
- Once signed in, you'll be brought to your personal dashboard. Click "Find Courses" in the top middle of your screen.
- In the left-hand column, under "Educational Provider," select "KENTUCKY BOARD OF EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES"
- This will show only KBEMS created courses. There should be three: KBEMS HIV-AIDS, KBEMS Provider Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma, and KBEMS Sexual Violence Awareness Course. They should be **FREE**. If they are not free, it is not the correct course.
- You need to complete both KBEMS Provider Pediatric Abusive Head Trauma, and KBEMS Sexual Violence Awareness Course.
- Click "Start Course," watch the YouTube video, complete the course survey, and you will receive your certificate.
- CEBroker will store your certificate, which is incredibly beneficial if you're ever audited by KBEMS.
